

Disciple-Making Team Qualifications

The following are the qualifications for becoming a Certified Disciple-Maker.

- 1. A Certified Disciple-Maker is a member in good standing of a Bible-believing, Christ-honoring local church.
- 2. A Certified Disciple-Maker has completed the Disciple-Making Team training.
- 3. A Certified Disciple-Maker is using the *Daily Life Journal* and making their way through the 2-Year *Walking Through the Word Daily Reading and Study Guide* that is included in the *Daily Life Journal*.
- 4. A Certified Disciple-Maker has completed an application for certification and has been through an interview conducted by another assigned Certified Disciple-Maker, and has sat in on one of their discipleship meetings to observe the process in action.
- 5. A Certified Disciple-Maker has read and signed the Covenantal Statement included in the application for certification.
